## **Demolition Permits**

- 1. Building permit issued by Municipal Inspection Services for Watertown Charter Township.
- 2. Provide letter of disconnection from all utilities, including, but not limited to, electric and natural gas.
- 3. Well head plugged and septic tank pumped, removed, filled, or crushed to Mid-Michigan District Health Department standards. Contact the Mid-Michigan District Health Department at 989-227-3107 or visit <a href="www.mmdhd.org">www.mmdhd.org</a> for more information.
- 4. Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control Permit or Exemption. Contact the Clinton County Building Department at (989) 224-5180 for more information.
- 5. Notify the Looking Glass Regional Fire Authority of demolition activities by calling 517-627-9831.
- 6. All debris must be removed from site and properly disposed of at a licensed disposal facility.
- 7. Foundation removed to a minimum of 24 inches below grade.
- 8. Entire remaining foundation filled with clean fill (no trash).
- 9. The top four to six inches must be covered with topsoil, seeded and covered with straw, when weather conditions permit. In the event of a winter demolition, seeding must occur by June 1.
